All,

In preparation for our January 30th meeting in Lancaster, we are providing some draft documents and maps for your review. We have conducted our latest round of analysis based on our previous discussions and factoring in your input and have new output to review. Specifically, there are three groups of data:

1. **GIS Suitability model results** – this is the model we have been discussing and this output reflects the best data we have to date. There are two important clarifications – we are still waiting for a more recent snowfall data layer as well as the new occurrence data from NHHNB. If we can get these before the meeting, we can run the model and bring the updated output with us. The attached maps give a thorough picture of the spatial relationships and model behavior.
2. **LiDAR Analysis results** – This is the more detailed analysis from the LiDAR data which shows up in panel four of the maps
3. **Draft workplan** – This provides more detail in our methodology for #1 and #2 above as well as our field protocol

Due to the file size of these I will be sending two separate e-mails and placing the high resolution maps on an ftp site. I am only attaching the lynx maps in this e-mail and will send the marten maps in the morning. The login for the ftp site is listed below – just click on the Northern Pass folder and all of the files will be there. Let me know if you are having any problems with this process.
