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Subject: Northern Pass Amended Presidential Permit Application

Greetings All:

As you may or may not be aware, Northern Pass has officially submitted the amended Presidential permit application to DOE for review. The application should be available on the project website, www.northernpasseis.us, by Monday evening (July 8th). Our field crews are currently conducting resource survey work on the lower 140 miles of the project. With a proposed route in the North Country, we need to commence resource survey work on that portion of the project.

Our project team would like to take the opportunity to present the details of the amended application and the process moving forward to the resource agencies and gather initial feedback, comments, questions you may have at that time. Also, during this meeting we would like to discuss any requested changes or amendments to the current work plans that would apply to the northern portion of the project.

At our last meeting, the group expressed an interest and goal of including all agencies in one meeting to have a more collaborative discussion. This would include EPA and USACE, along with the state and federal wildlife agencies. Please consider the following dates and let me know availability for what would be a 2-3 hour meeting: July 24, 25, 31 or Aug 1. Obviously schedules are hectic this time of year, but we would like to have this meeting sooner if possible to keep our field teams moving forward. Right now, we propose to again meet at USFWS in Concord if the conference room is available. However, if we need a space off-site to accommodate a larger group, I'm sure we can find one in Concord. Another option would be to find a space in Manchester to accommodate the EPA and USACE drive time from the Boston area (understanding this increases the drive time for the Lancaster group).

Please let me know your thoughts on dates, time preference (either a 9AM or 1PM start time) and location. We will schedule with the majority of the group's availability and preference.
