All,
I hope this email finds you all well. The SE Group Team will be conducting winter tracking surveys for Canada Lynx and American marten in the northern extent of the proposed Northern Pass Transmission Line Project Area (Northumberland to Pittsburg) during the upcoming winter field season. As you know, surveys were not completed in the "North 40" last year as a result of the lack of a finalized proposed route from Northern Pass. We anticipate using the same survey approach this year as was developed last year for the project (attached), but with slight modifications to incorporate the greater potential for lynx denning habitat to be present with the survey area. In preparation for the start of surveys, we would like to host a conference call to provide an update on the project as well as talk through the applicability of the survey methodology for the North 40. If possible we would like to have this call either late the week of January 6th or early the week of January 13th to ensure that field teams can mobilize by the end of January. Given the upcoming holidays, we would like to try to establish the date and time of the call now. Please let me know your schedule and preference for the date of a call. We look forward to speaking with you soon.
